Concept Design


Streets account for the biggest percentage of public space in our City and construction presents an opportunity to change a street's design to serve all users.

The design described below was decided upon based on the guidance and recommendations in the City's Vital Streets Plan and Bicycle Action Plan. At the meeting, we'll discuss the proposed concept design shown on the back of this letter.

Godfrey Avenue

The project will:

- Place new water main.
- This project will separate combined sewer into dedicated sanitary and storm sewers.
 - The sanitary sewer and sanitary laterals to the property line will be replaced.
 There will be no interruption to sewer service.
 - The storm sewer will be replaced with a new storm sewer main and stormwater inlets.
- Reconstruct the street, curb, and gutter, including:
 - Installing curb extensions at intersections to shorten pedestrian crossings, better define the parking lanes, and help slow traffic speeds.
 - Moving the curbs in on both sides to narrow the street from 42 feet wide to 32 feet wide.
- Maintain parking lane on the west side of the street from Chestnut Street to the railroad tracks.
- Maintain the parking lane on the east side of the street from B Street to Rumsey Street.
- Install a 14-foot shared use path on the east side of the street for people walking and bicycling.
- Plant new street trees.
- Replace all driveway approaches.

Chestnut Street

The project will:

- Reconstruct the street from Godfrey to 300 feet west of Godfrey.
- Remove and replace the existing road surface from 300 feet west of Godfrey to the west end.
- Install new sidewalk on the south side of Chestnut from Godfrey to Oxford Trail.
- Plant new street trees.
- Replace some driveway approaches.

Oxford Street


The project will:

- Remove the Oxford Street bridge and construct a new street. Please see visual at the end of this letter.
- Install new sidewalks on both sides of the street.
- Install parkways on both sides of the street to add more greenspace. The parkway is the area between the sidewalk and the street.
- This project will separate combined sewer into dedicated sanitary and storm sewers.


Business Guide
